## Protecting your future

Navigating payment models as they move from volume to value can be challenging. Patients deserve the best care possible, and you need to be recognized for the tremendous value you bring to care. We're fighting to make sure patients and pathologists win; some advocacy efforts include:

- Increased overall professional Medicare reimbursement for pathologists in 2017 by \$4.5 million in payments
- Extended the life of the CAPdeveloped quality measures, allowing pathologists to receive credit under the Physician Quality Reporting System and the new Meritbased Incentive Payment System (MIPS) program

- Leveled the playing field by lobbying with the CMS for a classification of nonpatient facing distinction for pathologists, allowing flexibility for complying with the new CMS Quality Payment Program
- Ensured informed and transparent Medicare coverage decisions by working with lawmakers to introduce legislation to improve transparency and accountability
- Promoted a favorable regulatory environment for patients, laboratories, and pathologists by ensuring regulations do not place undue burden on the profession

• Delivered key recommendations to the CMS leading to more favorable PAMA rules for laboratory compliance


